#### Nancy Nowak Utech (discipline: painting)

This artist, new to the festival, is known for her abstract paintings evocative of many emotions.



#### Rick Hunter (discipline: glass)

This artist, new to the festival, practices glass-blowing with old world technique to create exquisite and colorful works of original art.



#### Souphong Manikhong

(discipline: contemporary wood crafts)

This celebrated woodcraft artist uses rare woods, including exotic rosewoods, ebonies and burls of his native Laos.



#### Bruce Fairman (discipline: clay and ceramics)

This artist specializes in hand-thrown porcelain vases known for their classical Oriental-inspired simplicity and finished with the artist's own custom signature glaze developed over years.



#### Jim Lawrence (discipline: mixed media)

This artist, new to the festival, draws inspiration from ancient Indian rock art by combining hand-cut and polished unique stones with international exotic woods and finished with a fine oil.

#### Cheryl Senkfor (discipline: jewelry)

This artist, new to the festival, practices a technique called Viking Knit that uses 14k gold-filled, fine silver, copper and bronze metal wire to create a variety of signature pieces.
