TOUR DE SUMERLIN REGISTRATION CLOSING SOON

One of the most engaging public events in the master-planned community of Summerlin is right around the corner: The 12th annual Tour de Summerlin, Saturday, April 20. Online registration closes this Thursday, April 18. Last-minute registrations can be handled in person at McGhies Ski, Bike & Board on Friday, April 19, from noon to 7 p.m.

Tour de Summerlin is a non-competitive cycling event that features a 40-, 75- and 100-mile ride through the beautiful Summerlin landscape and neighboring Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area. Cyclists will enjoy courses that include Summerlin's dedicated bike routes and wide, open desert roads.

"What an incredible way to see the beautifully designed Summerlin neighborhoods and natural desert wilds," said Danielle Bisterfeldt, marketing director for the Howard Hughes Corporation, developer of Summerlin. "Tour de Summerlin is one way all Las Vegas residents can enjoy some of our 22,500 acre master-planned community as well as the best natural scenery in Southern Nevada created by Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area that runs along the western edge of the city.
